This year Blessed Sacrament Catholic School is incorporating a summer math requirement into our curriculum to help maintain skills and concepts learned throughout the year in math. Often times students struggle to retain information, so free accounts have been set up through Kahn Academy for your child to practice math during the summer break.

This summer, the emphasis for summer math will be as follows:

- ✓ Entering Sixth Grade: Multiplication, Division, Fractions, Place Value and Decimals
- ✓ Entering Seventh Grade: Ratios, Rates, Percentages and Arithmetic Operations
- ✓ Entering Eighth Grade: Negative Numbers (Multiplication/Division), Fractions, Decimals, Percentages and Geometry

Please have your child log on to [kahnacademy.org](http://kahnacademy.org) and click the login icon at the top right portion of the screen. Enter the user id and password provided to you. The requirement will be twenty minutes per day Monday-Friday during summer break from June 10<sup>th</sup> – August 9<sup>th</sup>. **Please have your child complete the assignments in the order presented** as concepts build upon each other.

Although a large number of assignments have been assigned, it is not the school's expectation that a student completes the summer math homework in its entirety. Rather, we hope students will spend at least 20 minutes a day working on essential math skills.
