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- Describe the rhyme scheme and rhythm of this poem. Is it regular or varied? Are there a certain number of beats or stresses in each line? How does the rhyme scheme impact the mood?  
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Think about the building blocks of a poem. Consider the overall shape, the number of stanzas, the length of each stanza, the rhythm and rhyme, and the creative aesthetics. How might the way the poem appears on the page shape its overall meaning and effect?
