



HSPT Frequently Asked Questions

How will students register?

Visit <https://stsusers.com/stsusers/registration/static/sanantonio.php> and follow the process by selecting the testing date and site as appropriate.

I received an email from Scholastic Testing Services about an account. What do I do?

If you received an email to set up an account, this is simply to have admin/viewer access to see who has registered for your campus. You can set up this account to monitor your 8th graders who have signed up for testing, but do not need to take any further action.

What if a student cannot test on December 11 or 12?

There will be a follow up testing date in the spring. We will open registration for that date and publish it after the December 12 testing.

Can a student take the test more than one time?

Only the first attempt of the test will be counted for admission purposes.

Do the middle school campuses have to order tests?

No, the DCS is handling the order for the December 11 date. Materials will be delivered to your campus on or before November 30.

What if I would like for the high schools to provide proctors for my campus?

Please fill out this form and the high schools will coordinate with you if you would like a proctor.

When will we know who is testing on our campus?

Registration for the 12/11 test closes at midnight of 12/9. On 12/10, we will send you a complete list of those that are testing at your campus on 12/11. Registration for the 12/12 test closes at midnight of 12/10. On 12/11, we will send the high schools a complete list of those that are testing at your campus on 12/12.

What do we do about accommodations?

There is a pdf for an accommodation form on the registration website. This should be filled out and returned to the campus by 12/2. In the meantime, you can work on identifying your 8th grade students who may need accommodations by using this form.
